

LEWES SUMMER LACROSSE LEAGUE FOR GIRLS

Who: Anybody going into 9th grade and up who has played before and/or will play next year in college or high school

What: Pick-up game(s) will be organized from whoever shows up. A reversible tank-top will be provided to differentiate teams. A certified official will be provided to officiate all games

How Do I Become Eligible to Play: Pay the one time fee of \$25 (used to defray the cost of the reversible, administrative costs and the official) and sign a waiver form. If you are under 18, the waiver must be signed by a parent.

When Will It Start: Wednesday June 17th at 6:00 for younger players* and 7:00 for older players**

How Long Will it Run: Every Wednesday from June 17th to July 22nd

What to bring: You must provide your own stick, mouth guard and protective goggles. No one will be allowed to play unless they have all the protective gear called for in the NCAA rules

Where: On the field behind the 9th grade campus of Cape Henlopen High School. On the left hand side of Savannah Road just before you get to Beebe Medical Center and downtown Lewes
